REPORT OF FIRE INVESTIGATION WORKING GROUP

The CTIF Fire Investigation Working Group (WG) organized its annual meeting in a virtual form, which was held on 23 May 2022. The meeting was organized by the National Directorate General for Disaster Management, Hungary. Ten fire investigation experts from six member states attended the online meeting. Participants shared case studies and discussed the working group's future plans.

The representatives of the Czech Republic, Denmark and Hungary presented a fire investigation case study. The speakers presented complex fire investigation cases about an asylum and a hospital fire. These presentations pointed out the importance of taking into account the changed fire protection requirements related to the changed purpose in case of a building.

Brigadier General Dr. László Bérczi the chair of the WG called the members to propose to organize the next meeting in autumn 2022. Unfortunately, mostly because of financial reasons, it have not been organized.
