

## CTIF sent to the General Assembly 2021-2022

### **1. Report on the work of the Fire Investigation Working Group:**

There was an online meeting of the fire investigation working group on May 23rd. The meeting was organized by Hungary. Hungary, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland and Lithuania have joined. Three countries gave presentations on interesting fire investigations. Presentations were sent to members.

After that, we discussed the basics of the fire investigation expert system. We want to continue this work. We also want to have a personal meeting this year in October. We are now organizing and waiting for members to apply. The location has not been decided yet.

### **2. Report on the work of the Fire Prevention Committee:**

Unfortunately, we have had a difficult task since the resignation of President Ales Jug (2020) and the COVID pandemic. Hungary is organizing and looking for member states as an administrator, but we have not made any significant progress. We asked for candidates for the presidency, but only Hungary gave names. The Hungarian candidate is a recognized fire protection specialist. Fire Colonel Ferenc Érces with more than 40 professional backgrounds and experience. In May of this year, we announced an online committee meeting, but only one country applied, so we didn't hold it. Of course, we will continue to work and re-announce the possibility of an online conference in September. It is important to choose the person of the president.
